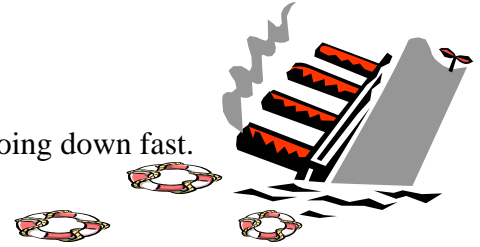
GRAVE AND IMMINENT DANGER

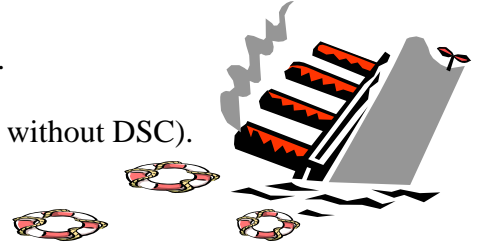
GRAVE AND IMMINENT DANGER

Write the distress call and distress message you would send on MF/HF (a set without DSC).

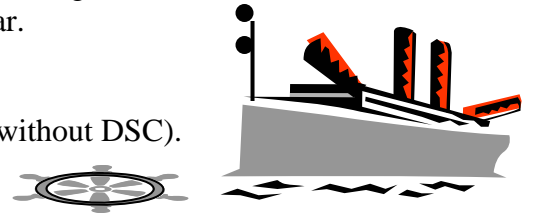

Write the appropriate call and message you would send on VHF (a set without DSC).

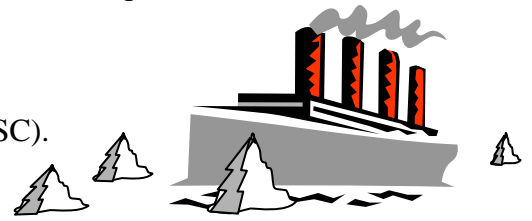
