

## PORT SAR EX 4– INCIDENT SCENE RISK ASSESSMENT & RETRIEVAL FROM ROCKS OR BEACH


### Task & Purpose:

To gain local knowledge of bombies, gather task information, develop a plan, recovery of vessels and occupant skills, and provide simulated medical rescue.

### Initial (task information) Report:

**1330** - Message from SARCC to duty skipper –



- White sailboat/dinghy/or a duck stranded on Pilot Beach (31° 25′.5 S 152° 54′.8 E)  
or Flagstaff Rocks North (31° 25′.8 S 152° 55′.3 E)  
or Nobbies Rocks North (31° 26′.8 S 152° 56′.0 E)

<b>Team member names and date of exercise:</b>

## Scenario- Requested additional information:

**1400** - Reply from SARCC to duty skipper request for additional information –

- One person was aboard and is now presumed missing.

<b>Now prepare your Operational Plan</b>	
Operational information: <i>Departure point-</i> <i>Conditions-</i> <i>Forecast -</i> <i>Tides -</i> <i>Daylight -</i> <i>Hazards -</i>	Compile information from today's conditions.
The SAR plan and brief of personnel.    Search pattern & datum.	
On scene risk assessment.	
De-briefing.  	Did you: Approach the incident scene and make a hazard assessment? Right the craft and tow off? Organise land based comms. to ascertain the persons missing? Search the downwind/current shore for survivors? Arrange for paramedics to attend and specify a rendezvous?
Exercise corresponds to: Motorboat Simulator Ex. 1., Port Scenery.	White sailboat in surf at locations (31° 25'.5 S 152° 54'.8 E) (31° 25'.8 S 152° 55'.3 E) (31° 26'.8 S 152° 56'.0 E)
