

PORT SAR EX 5 – INTER SERVICE COOPERATIVE INSHORE RESCUE

Task & purpose:

To gather task information, develop a plan, test & troubleshoot inter-service coordination of communications and provide simulated medical rescue.


Requirement:

Training officers will best conduct this exercise in cooperation with other SLSC, SES & marine operators/interested business.

Initial (task information) Report:

1330 - Message from SARCC to duty skipper –



- Three or more swimmers are swept away at Lighthouse beach.

Scenario- Requested additional information:

1400 - Reply from SARCC to duty skipper request for additional information –

- One man in blue swim suit, one male child 12 years on red boogie board LKP Watonga rock at 1300. No other missing persons.

Subsequent en-route update reports:

1445 - Message from Police to SARCC –

- Man in blue found on beach at 1 NM south of SLSC holding a red boogie board. He is shivering, disorientated & insists on swimming “out there” to find his son.

1500 - Message from Police to SARCC –

- Seaplane reports floating object at 0.5 NM south of SLSC in 4 mtrs, 150 mtrs off beach.
